Kirkbrae is the perfect environment to transition from independent to assisted living.

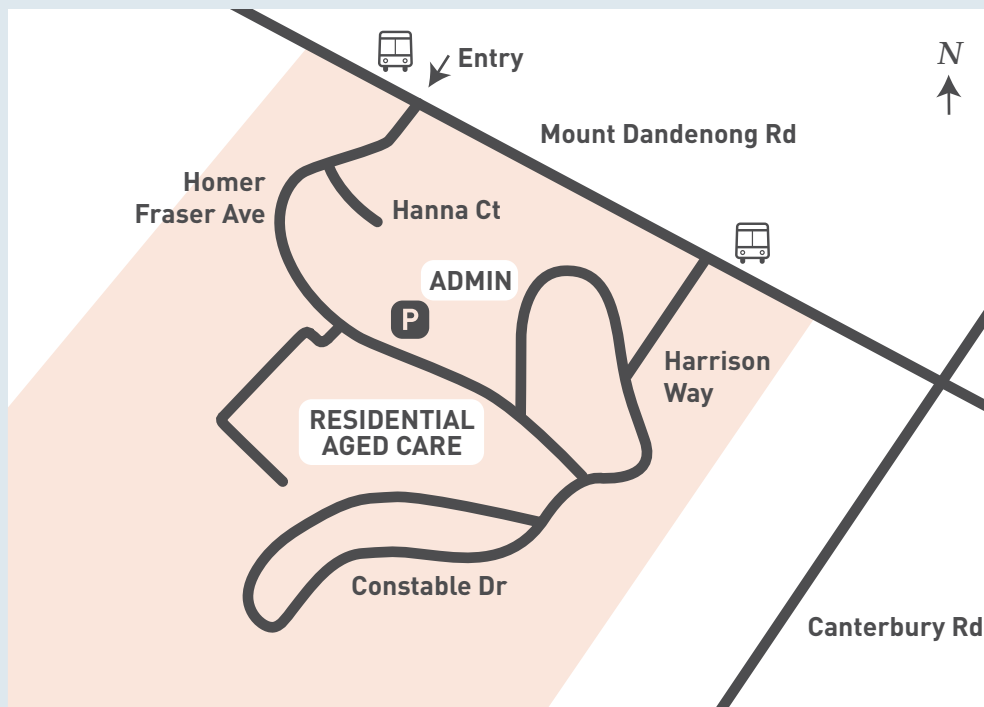
